Together with seven other Professors the chair constitutes the academic backbone of our initiative DIGITAL SPACE – The HHL Digital Transformation Platform. Within this initiative, HHL is also building up a strong research group in Strategic Entrepreneurship with currently over 15 Ph.D. students with whom the appointed candidate can pursue research activities. The role is suitable for young scholars eager to develop a strong teaching and research traction, or for experienced Post-Docs looking to strengthen their profile for future positions.

In the field of research, the potential to develop an internationally recognized innovation management and entrepreneurship research reputation is of very high importance. The candidate should show a track record of publications in international high-quality journals with high impact. Experience in a business school environment should be reflected by an obtained doctoral degree or experience from a leading European or international Business School or University.
