

Since the beginning of April, Bérangère Deschamps (University of Grenoble Alpes - France) and Céline Barrédy (University of Paris Nanterre) are Editor-in-Chief of the *Revue de l'Entrepreneuriat*. They are closely supported by Hedi Yezza (EDC Paris) in the role of editorial secretary. The *Revue de l'Entrepreneuriat* is ranked 2 by FNEGE, the French Ranking of Management Science reviews and journals.

The team is extended to associate editors: Andrea Calabro (IPAG - France), Benoit Demil (University of Lille - France), Cécile Fonrouge (University of Quebec at Trois-Rivières - Canada), Anaïs Hamelin (University of Strasbourg - France), Martine Hlady-Rispal (University of Limoges - France), Vincent Lefebvre (AUDENCIA School of Business - France), Nathalie Schieb-Bienfait (University of Nantes - France).

The tenure (2020-2023) is based on a program of projects the editorial team aims to implement:

- # The first of these concerns is the implementation of an online process of Submissions and evaluations: https://www.editorialmanager.com/entrepreneuriat/
- # We also wish the journal to become fully bilingual. Articles in English are welcome. For all accepted articles, authors will be asked to provide a translation into English or French, as the case may be, in order to increase the international visibility of the research in entrepreneurship published in the *Revue de l'Entrepreneuriat*. In this perspective, the guidelines for authors and reviewers have evolved to be consistent with international standards. They are available on the platform, in French and in English.
- # The third concerns the duration of the evaluation process, which we want to be short, maximum a year, after the first submission of an article.
- # To this is added the recognition that we aim to bring to the evaluators who contribute to the proper functioning of the journal, by various actions in their favor (price of the best evaluator, nomination of the evaluators of the year on the website of the Journal). We wish to continue the work of promoting the *Revue de l'Entrepreneuriat* in national and international rankings.
- # Among the new actions, the editorial team plans to launch a call for special issues, annual, broadcast on September 15<sup>th</sup> with the deadline for submission December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, whose intention is to select special issues which will be supported and produced the following year in the *Revue de l'Entrepreneuriat*.
- # Finally, we wish to create a place of exchange around the review by writing a quarterly "newsletter" whose vocation is to keep the community informed of our actions under the review, but also of the links that can be develop with other places of scientific production dedicated to entrepreneurship, in particular the AEI.
